

BY-LAWS

NORTH CAROLINA ENTOMOLOGICAL SOCIETY

Article I - FEES AND DUES

Dues shall be set upon recommendation of the Executive Committee and a majority vote of members present at the annual meeting. (10/90)

The financial accounts of the Treasurer shall be audited annually by the Auditing Committee and a written report of such audit shall be submitted by the Auditing Committee to the membership at the annual meeting.

Article II - ELECTION OF OFFICERS

The officers of the North Carolina Entomological Society shall be elected at the annual meeting. Nominees shall be selected by the Nominating Committee and nominations may also be submitted from the floor. A majority vote of members present at the annual meeting shall decide the election.

Article III - PROGRAM

The entomological program of the meeting shall be arranged and selected by the Program Committee. (10/90)

Article IV - ORDER OF BUSINESS

The Annual Meeting shall be conducted in the following order:

2. Preliminary business meeting
 - a. Report of Secretary-Treasurer
 - b. Report of Standing Committees
 - c. Announcement of new members
 - d. Old business
 - e. New business
 - f. Consideration of time and place of next annual meeting
 - g. Appointment of Committees
3. General Program
4. Final business meeting
 - a. Old and new business
 - b. Report of special and temporary committees
 - c. Election of officers
5. Adjournment

Article V - AMENDMENTS

The By-Laws of the North Carolina Entomological Society may be amended at any annual meeting by a two-thirds vote of those members present and voting.

Article VI - KULASH-FULTON MEMORIAL FUND, INC.

The North Carolina Entomological Society shall establish the Kulash-Fulton Memorial Fund for the purposes of a) providing loans or grants to deserving students in entomology; b) encouraging publication of scientific or literary treatises explaining, publicizing or promoting entomological endeavors; and c) promoting research through educational endeavors.
